Summaries of these notebooks are given below listing the dates and places visited with details of the contents, particularly the records of birds and other fauna, to provide a key to Buddle's collecting, photography and other interests.

The notebooks are hand-written in pencil and have a consistent style throughout, with records of the persons involved, the weather conditions and other details. Visits and expeditions to islands are an important feature. Besides the presence and size of nesting colonies and information on species local to particular islands, there are observations made at sea. Other fieldwork covered sites in the Auckland region and elsewhere, particularly coastal areas and wetlands, where Buddle recorded a wealth of information on the fauna and flora of these specialised habitats. He seems to have had a flair for finding bird nests and the notebooks provide many records, including those of fernbird, pipit, bittern, and dabchick which he also photographed, often using a tent as a hide.

Buddle's notebooks are an important historical source of information on New Zealand's natural history recorded at first hand over a 15-year period by a careful observer.

Canton Island Notebook 1937

Expedition to observe solar eclipse on Canton Is. 18/5 to 5/7/1937 [Entries often cover several pages for each date; this summary records the main features & picks out the ornithological details]

Notes (*nesting, +specimen, Photo/Movie) Left Auckland by 'Niagara' Usual petrels; vast number of diving petrels. Then no birds until near Suva on 21/5 - frigates & 1 or 2 petrels. On to HMS 'Wellington' with Michie.
