out. My dearest old pal was wounded in the Somme aavance. I am told that he was hit with thrappel and machine que bullet. He had 44 bounds in his body but not a scratch on his face or head. He was taken to the Military Hospital at Etaples and was progressing wonderfully When Gangerine poisoning set In upon his worm do which home Can stand and the worst happened. Poor old Spud was hot in the least troubled with his bounds, he was as bright and as cheery as he always haturally was with he passed away and went West. He had a lovely funeral with

full military honours and has now a most beautiful tombstono and cross over his grave. I have Seen it. On soon as I found out where it was I went an a paid my bery but respect to it. It was an awful thing for me to do when I spend the padded moments at the side of my poor dear departed pal.
