Call for Nominations for Election to the Auckland Museum Institute Council 2018

Nominations are called for *seven* of the twelve positions on Council.

- Dr Roger Buchanan and Scott Pilkington have reached the end of their first term and are eligible for re-election for a second term.
- John McIntyre and Helen Bull have reached the end of their second term and are eligible for re-election for a third term.
- John Denton, Elspeth Carroll and Associate Professor Linda Tyler are standing down.
- Continuing Council Members are Marguerite Durling, Dr Margaret Horsburgh, Dr Judith McMorland, Jon Moses and Professor Cristin Print.
- Dr Roger Lins and Rae Nield, currently serving as advisory (non-voting) members, are eligible to stand for election.

Additional persons who wish to be nominated must be life or financial members for at least a full year (Rules 5.3, 5.4). Proposer and Secunder must be life, honorary life, or financial annual members of the Institute. Nominees must commit to the nomination by signing the form and are invited to provide additional information on the reverse of the nomination form. Information provided will be sent out with the voting papers (Rule 5.5).

Nominations must be submitted on the attached form on or before **Tuesday 30 October 2018 at 3.00pm**. Nominations received after this time will not be accepted.
